Background:

At last week's City Council meeting (March 28), two developers presented three development designs to Council for consideration. During that meeting, it was decided *unanimously* by the Council to delay the process, allowing for additional public meetings to give residents the opportunity to meet the developers, ask questions, and provide feedback helpful to Council in making a decision.

Following direction from Council, we have scheduled two public meetings, both on **Wednesday, April 18th, the first one at 10:00 a.m. and another one at 6:00 p.m.** Both will be held at the Municipal Services Building, 33 Arroyo Drive, in the atrium (outside of the Council Chambers). We chose to have two meetings at different times to accommodate people that either work during the day, or work in the evening.

We hope you can join us at one of these, learn more and provide your feedback concerning the proposed developments. All feedback received will be provided to Council prior to any decision being made. After our April 18th public meetings, the Council will again take up this item at a regular Council meeting, likely on **Wednesday, April 25th at 7:00 p.m.** Please visit our website at www.ssf.net for updated meeting schedules and agendas.
