**PROTECTED TREE PRUNING OR REMOVAL
APPLICATION**

As required by the Tree Preservation Ordinance No. 1271-2000, Municipal Code Chapter 13.30, this application form is required for permission to prune or remove a tree. **One permit is required for each tree removal or pruning request.** Applications should be submitted to the Parks and Recreation Department at the address indicated below. If approved for pruning or removal, approved permits shall expire after four months. Owners shall reapply if work has not been completed within four months of issuance of permit. Application fee is \$100.00, due upon submittal of application, payable to: City of South San Francisco. A \$350 tree replanting deposit is also due if replanting of trees is required, and is refundable upon replanting.

Any upright, single-trunked tree of the following species: Blue Gum (Eucalyptus globulus), Black Acacia (Acacia melanoxylon), Myoporum (Myoporum laetum), Sweetgum (liquidambar styraciflua), Glossy Privet (Lingustrum lucidum), or Lombardy Poplar (Populus nigra) with a circumference of 75 inches or more when measured 54 inches above natural grade
- () 3. Any upright, single-trunked tree considered to be a Heritage Tree species, with a circumference of 30 inches or more when measured at 54 inches above natural grade. A Heritage Tree is any of the following: California Bay (Umbellaria californica), Oak (Quercus spp.), Cedar (Cedrus spp.), California Buckeye (Aesculus californica), Catalina Ironwood (Lyonothamnus asplenifolium), Strawberry Tree (Arbutus spp.), Little Gem Dwarf Southern Magnolia (Magnolia grandiflora ‘Little Gem’) or Mayten (Maytenus boaria)
- () 4. A tree or stand of trees so designated by the director based upon findings that it is unique and of importance to the public due to its unusual appearance, location, historical significance or other factor
- () 5. A stand of trees in which the director has determined each tree is dependent upon the others for survival.

Do not prune or remove any tree until the signed permit with approvals and conditions is returned to you. Notices will be sent to all properties within 100 feet with a 10-day limit for comments.

I understand that there is a \$350.00 tree planting deposit that will be returned when I meet the tree replacement conditions in accordance with South San Francisco Tree Preservation Ordinance No. 1271-2000, Municipal Code Chapter 13.30. If I do not meet the permit conditions within 4 months of the tree removal date, I understand that the \$350.00 deposit will be placed into the Tree Planting Fund to cover costs of planting a tree in the City of South San Francisco, and for necessary inspections or other administrative costs.
