Those Telecommunications Companies that submit a Notice of Intent to Participate and meet the criteria established by the City as being a competent service provider will be notified within 14 calendar days of the due date of the Notice of Intent and will be invited to participate in the project. It is the responsibility of Comcast LLC and respondents to negotiate the scope and terms of collocation work in good faith. If a respondent believes that Comcast LLC is not negotiating in good faith, then a protest detailing the dispute may be submitted to the Public Works Department.

Notice of Intent to Participate

This Notice of Intent to Participate is submitted in response to the Public Notice to Telecommunications Service Providers dated September 25, 2019 issued by the City of South San Francisco Public Works Department for collocating telecommunication facilities in the public right-of-way as part of the Comcast LLC Project # JB86765 located on the following Public Streets:

1445 San Mateo Avenue from San Mateo Avenue around Lowrie Avenue

Description of Work:

This project proposes to bore 1,284 ft and trench 80 ft to install 2-2 inch HDPE conduits, overlash 2,489 ft and place 601 ft of new strand, install 8 new traffic rated CATV vaults and 2 new B36 CATV vaults, and install 977 ft of aerial drop to target buildings along Lowrie Ave and San Mateo Ave.

It is understood that the scope and terms of the collocation work will be negotiated in good faith directly with the Comcast LLC. It is also understood that all Telecommunications Service Providers require an executed Encroachment Agreement with the City of South San Francisco prior to the installation of any telecommunication facilities in the Public right-of-way.

By the signature herein, I hereby certify that the Utility named below is a telecommunications provider operating under the authority of the California Public Utilities Commission to operate as a full facilities based competitive local exchange carrier and desires to place facilities to do so in the City of South San Francisco's public right-of-way.
