As your Councilmember, I've secured \$9 million to expand childcare in Westborough, \$2 million to extend the Free South City Shuttle into Westborough, over \$1 million to improve bicycle and pedestrian safety, and \$1 million to repair Westborough Park's walking paths. We've repaved Westborough's streets, installed free wi-fi at Westborough Park, and opened the new Civic Center Campus and Orange Memorial Park's new ballfields. During COVID, I spearheaded Guaranteed Basic Income and emergency rental assistance to help our neighbors.

I'll keep providing our police more public safety tools like Automatic License Plate Readers to fight crime. And I'll continue advocating for more affordable housing—California recognizes South San Francisco as a housing-friendly city and awarded \$28 million for affordable housing.

I've been a South San Francisco resident for over 30 years and live with my wife and two children in Westborough. I'm a former Legislative Aide to Assemblymember Gene Mullin and Congresswoman Jackie Speier and current Government Representative for BART. I became South San Francisco's first Filipino Mayor in 2022.
