CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS IN SSF

428 BADEN AVENUE

PG&E will be completing work along 3rd Lane between Maple Ave. and Spruce Ave. Work will result in road closure between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., daily between Tuesday, March 12th and Tuesday, March 26th. The contractor will maintain vehicular access for residents on 3rd Lane.

The sidewalk along the project's Baden Ave. frontage is closed. The sidewalk will be reopened in a subsequent phase of work. Pedestrian detour signage is deployed, noting a safe path of travel around the work area. Additionally, the

project expects daily material deliveries, and additional truck traffic is expected. The contractor will maintain vehicular access to Baden Ave. and 3rd Ln. Drivers can expect minor delays. Construction flaggers will be deployed during material deliveries. Please always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.



CENTENNIAL TRAIL PARK SOUTH

The Centennial Trail Improvements project continues. Access to the project is from S. Spruce Ave. using the maintenance driveway. Construction traffic will be temporarily directed into the construction area from S. Spruce Ave. using

Centennial Trail. Trail users may be impacted. Flaggers will be available to direct trail users and construction traffic during the temporary construction vehicle detour.

Work hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. For additional information about this project, please visit www.ssf.net/parkprojects.

El CAMINO REAL (Between Arroyo Dr. and Kaiser Way)

Improvements continue along El Camino Real between Arroyo Dr. and Kaiser Way as part of the Grand Blvd. project which includes improvements to sidewalks, planting, roadway, lighting, and landscaping. Work is currently focused along the southbound side of El Camino Real and Del Paso Dr. Minor lane shifts will be deployed as work is underway along El Camino Real (weather dependent). Pedestrian detour signage when required will be deployed, noting a safe path of travel around the work area. Drivers can expect minor delays. Please always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.



GRAND AVE. & AIRPORT BLVD. STREETSCAPE IMPROVEMENT

Streetscape improvement work at the intersection of Grand Ave. and Airport Blvd. continues. The work will improve all four corners of the intersection, including the medians. The work is being phased to minimize impacts.

Paving work, involving roadway restoration, is currently ongoing and will be carried out in phases to minimize disruptions. Less disruptive activities will take place between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday. More impactful work will occur during nighttime between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. (weather permitting). The work will result in single-lane closures impacting northbound & southbound travel along Airport Blvd. and Grand Ave.

intersection. Delays are expected during working hours.

Due to the weather, the previous scheduled nightwork was postponed.

Nightwork along Airport Blvd. between Baden Ave. and Miller Ave. is now scheduled (weather dependent) between the nights of March 17th to March 21st between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

Commuters are encouraged to use alternate routes during work days. Work hours are between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Construction flaggers will be present to assist with vehicular travel as needed.

Pedestrian detour signage will be in place to guide pedestrians around the work zones. Access for pedestrians to the Caltrain Station will be maintained.

Please adhere to signs and follow instructions from safety personnel for your safety and that of others.



OYSTER POINT IIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Construction has begun Oyster Point Marina/Park. The entire section of E. Basin Rd. at Marina Blvd. is closed during the duration of the project. The E. portion of the Bay Trail will be detoured for the duration of the project, while the West portion will remain open except for a short periodic disruption. Pedestrian detour signage has been deployed, routing pedestrian around the open portions of the Bay Trail.

Parking lot is closed at the lower parking lot near the windsurf ramp and picnic area. The parking lot for trailers will be impacted by losing around 10 stalls for staging area but will remain open to the public.

The Oyster Point boat launch, fishing pier, public bathrooms and Dominic's at Oyster Point will remain open during constructions. The Windsurf launch ramp will remain closed during construction.

PG&E SUBSTATION (Gateway Blvd. between E. Grand Ave. and Oyster Point Blvd.)

Work continues along Gateway Blvd. between E. Grand Ave. and Oyster Point Blvd. Work will result in lane closure on northbound Gateway Blvd. and eastbound Oyster Point Blvd. The work will proceed over the weekend to minimize disruptions on:

1. Saturday, March 23
2. Saturday, March 30
3. Sunday, March 31
4. Sunday, April 7

Travel through Gateway Blvd. and Oyster Point Blvd. will be maintained, but commuters are encouraged to use alternate routes as there may be momentary delays. Construction flaggers will be deployed to help keep vehicular travel when necessary. The sidewalks will remain open as work is underway.

As part of this work, PG&E will be coordinating with impacted businesses/customers as there is an expected power outage. Businesses/customers impacted will receive a notice directly from PG&E if they fall on the impact zone. Power outage is expected on Sunday, March 31 and Sunday, April 7.



2023 STREET SURFACE PROJECT

City continues work on its 2023 Street Improvement Project along various streets west of US-101 (see map below). Work will be phased to minimize impacts from construction. Work will proceed daily between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Repair of failed street sections (Base Repairs) will occur during the upcoming two weeks in the following locations:

March 11-15:

- Grand Ave. from Spruce Ave. to Airport Blvd.
- First Ln. from Spruce Ave. to Linden Ave.
- Third Ln. from Chestnut Ave. to Eucalyptus Ave.
- Fourth Ln. from Cypress Ave. to Maple Ave.
- Grand Ave. from Spruce Ave. to Orange Ave.

Notice will be posted along impacted areas 72-hours in advance of impact.

Local access will be maintained throughout most phases of work. Delays are expected and commuters are encouraged to use alternate routes. Please always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.



SMART CORRIDORS EXPANSION PROJECT

The Smart Corridor Expansion project is a joint effort by the City and Caltrans to develop a traffic management system along key arterial corridors that parallel US-101 and I-380. The Smart Corridor program provides public agencies the tools to safely manage traffic congestion through local streets during normal operating conditions, major freeway incidents, and special

events.

The project stretches along the following:

1. Airport Blvd.: US-101 (City limit) to Terminal Ct.
2. S. Airport Blvd.: Road 21 to Mitchell Ave.
3. Gateway Blvd.: Mitchell Ave. to Oyster Point Blvd.

Work will proceed daily (Monday through Friday). Some work will be performed at night to alleviate possible congestion resulting from this work.

March 11th to March 22th, 2024 (Typical work hours 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.)

- S. Airport at Wondercolor
- S. Airport between 101 Off Ramp and San Bruno
- Northbound and Southbound Gateway Blvd. between E. Grand Ave. and Mitchell Ave.
- Gateway and Oyster Point
- Linden Ave., Canal to Baden


March 11th to March 15th, 2024 (Work Hours 11 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.)

- S. Airport from Canal to San Bruno

Commuters can expect delays and are encouraged to use alternate routes.

30 TANFORAN AVE. - SOUTHLINE DEVELOPMENT

Utility work continues impacting multiple streets and serving as a frontage to the project. The work is being phased to minimize vehicle and pedestrian travel disruptions. The work will proceed as follows:

- **South Linden Ave.** between Victory Ave. and Dollar Ave. parking will be restricted during working hours to allow temporary lane shifts to occur as work is underway between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Lane shifts will impact both the northbound and southbound travel on S. Linden Ave.
- **Dollar Ave.** between Tanforan Ave. and S. Linden Ave. parking will be restricted during working hours to allow temporary lane shifts to occur between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Lane shifts will impact both the northbound and southbound travel on Dollar Ave.
- **Tanforan Ave.** between Dollar Ave. and S. Maple Ave. parking will be restricted during working hours to allow temporary lane shifts to occur between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Lane shifts will impact both the northbound and southbound travel on Dollar Ave. Additionally, work within the site will be proceeding under extended hours to 11:00 p.m. through Friday, March 8th.
- **South Maple Ave.** between Browning Way to Tanforan Ave. will be closed. South Maple Ave. will have NO access for traffic vehicles except for emergency vehicles. A portion of Centennial Way Trail will also be closed, pedestrian traffic will be rerouted to the sidewalk on the east side of South Maple Ave. The closure will remain for the whole duration of work.

Commuters can expect delays and are encouraged to use alternate routes. Construction flaggers will be deployed to help maintain vehicular travel. Please

always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.



UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD REPLACEMENT (Gateway Blvd. between S. Airport Blvd. & E. Grand Ave.)

Union Pacific will be completing railroad repairs at its crossing on Gateway Blvd. between S. Airport Blvd. and E. Grand Ave. Work will result closure of Gateway Blvd. at the railroad crossing to traffic beginning on Saturday, March 23 at 6:00 a.m. until Monday, March 25 at 8:00 a.m. During the closure, no thru traffic will be permitted. Detour signage will be deployed prior to closure with routes identified along westside of US-101 and eastside of US-101. Message boards and public notices will be set prior to the closure.

Drivers can expect delays and are encouraged to plan route accordingly. Please always follow the signs and safety personnel instructions.



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
