



POLYSTYRENE “FOAM” BAN

Effective January 1, 2025



Effective January 1, 2025, the City of South San Francisco will prohibit the retail sale of expanded or extruded polystyrene (EPS) foam food service ware (e.g. foam plates, bowls, cups, lids, trays). These products are sometimes referred to as EPS or Styrofoam™ and may have a #6 resin code on the bottom and are white in color. The purpose of the ordinance is to reduce polystyrene foam food ware in waterways and improve water quality and protect our community’s health against microplastics.
