- During this past council meeting, City Council passed an <u>anti-displacement plan</u>, investing \$400k towards researching policies that will prevent homelessness, keep families in their homes, and support local small businesses against displacement.
- City Council also passed a resolution calling for an <u>immediate</u> <u>permanent bilateral ceasefire</u>, the release of all hostages held, humanitarian aid for civilians in Gaza, and calling for protection of the security of all innocent civilians in Israel and Palestine.
