SSF Receives \$28 Million Grant for Affordable Housing

In 2022, the City applied for an Infill Infrastructure Grant (IIG) from the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) to support the construction of the infrastructure and affordable housing. The Project includes 800 housing units (of which 158 units will be affordable), publicly accessible open space, a new bridge over Colma Creek connecting Mission Road to Civic Campus Way, more parking spaces for the Library | Parks and Rec Center, a childcare center serving over 75 children, and a market hall with neighborhood serving retail. The City was awarded \$28,817,500 and City Council voted to authorize the acceptance of those funds in our most recent

Applicants will receive confirmation of their participation status by Friday, August 16, 2024. Once accepted, applicants must pay a \$50 participation fee.
