







#### **Orange Pool Today**

## Water Area = 3,150sf 6 Lanes




#### **The New Orange Aquatic Center**

## **Water Area = 11,825sf 17 lanes**
















#### Results

#### Opt1 + ScrWall

- The addition of the porous element atop the perimeter wall increases the overall distance / wake of protection within the pool area.
- Several measurement locations are expected to improve to wind conditions comfortable for sitting.
- In order to reduce wind speeds and shelter a larger section of the pool area, the porous section of wall would likely need to be doubled in height (5' to 10') as a minimum.
