1. Genentech Inc / Applicant


Consideration and approval of Genentech's acquisition of certain public rights-of-way within the Genentech Campus, including the entirety of DNA Way and Point San Bruno Boulevard, and Cabot Road from Allerton Road to DNA Way.

If you challenge in court the action taken by the City Council regarding the items described above, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing.

This meeting is held in-person. In the event that the City Council meets by teleconference under circumstances permitted by and consistent with the Brown Act as amended by AB 361 (2021), the City will not provide a physical location for members of the public to participate in the teleconference meeting.
