Our program offers free tutoring in reading, writing and financial coaching to English-speaking adults in South San Francisco, Daly City, San Bruno and Town of Colma.

We make a difference!

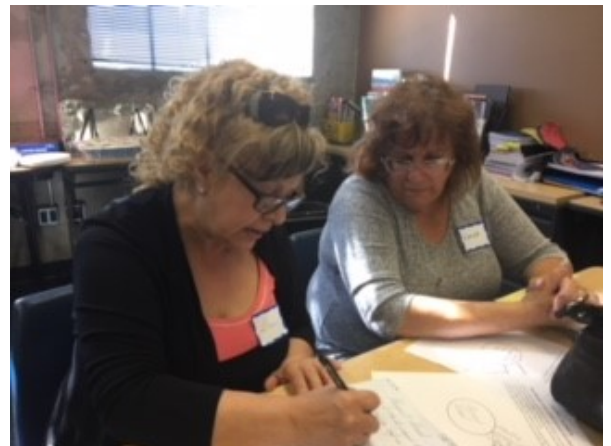
Adult learners in Project Read improve their literacy and financial skills enabling them to be more effective on the job and at home while being more engaged in their local communities. Many learners experience the pleasure of reading to a child for the first time, receiving recognition at work or passing the GED for a brighter future.

- Since 1985 Project Read has:
 - helped more than 4,850 adults achieve their literacy goals,
 - trained more than 3,150 volunteer tutors,
 - distributed over 114,050 books to low-income families through Learning Wheels.
- Annually, Project Read volunteers donate more than 6,000 hours of free community service.
- In 2018, Learning Wheels provided 180 programs that benefited 7,867 children and adults with books, workshops and Storytime events.
- In 2019, Project Read's free tax preparation service filed over 385 returns for low-income taxpayer households, giving back \$457,198 in refunds to our community.
