To help people get to holiday parties and seasonal travel destinations safely, The South San Francisco Police Department will have extra officers on patrol starting Black Friday (November 29<sup>th</sup>) looking for drivers who are suspected of being under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.

The enforcement efforts are part of a national enforcement campaign to discourage impaired driving from November 29<sup>th</sup> through December 10<sup>th</sup>.

“We want everyone to enjoy the holidays and being responsible plays a major part in that,” said Master Traffic Sergeant Danny Gil. “The danger is clear so before you head out for a party, make sure you have a safe way to get home.”

Alcohol is not the only thing that affects your driving ability. Prescription medications, over-the-counter drugs and marijuana can also impair, especially in combination with alcohol and other drugs.

So if you plan on drinking or taking drugs that can impair, play it safe and have a designated sober driver.
