ORDINANCE SUMMARY

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTERS 2.52, 2.56,
2.60, 2.62, 2.64, AND 2.80, OF THE SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO
MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO ELIGIBILITY
REQUIREMENTS FOR CITY COMMISSIONERS.**

1. SUMMARY

The City Council of the City of South San Francisco (“City”) has introduced, on February 26 2020, and proposes to adopt, on March 11, 2020, an ordinance amending Title 2, Chapters 2.52, 2.56, 2.60, 2.62, 2.64, and 2.80, of the South San Francisco Municipal Code (“Ordinance”). The proposed Ordinance would respond to recent changes to California law, as enacted by Senate Bill 225, by permitting any South San Francisco resident to serve on the City’s boards and commissions, subject to other qualifications as may be required for each respective body. Previously, the City’s Municipal Code required all board and commission members to be electors of the City. The proposed Ordinance, if adopted, would modify this requirement.

2. This Ordinance Summary was prepared pursuant to Government Code Section 36933. The City Council ordered preparation of this Ordinance Summary by the City Attorney.

3. The City Council introduced the Ordinance at its regular meeting held February 26, 2020 and it is scheduled for adoption at the regular meeting of March 11, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal Services Building Council Chambers, 33 Arroyo Drive, South San Francisco, CA.
