Transportation

The City of South San Francisco has a diverse transportation system that comprises the freeway and roadway system, public transportation, BART, Caltrain, water transit ferry, employee shuttle system, bicycling and walking, and San Francisco International Airport. The city is served by two major north-south freeways, US 101 and I-280, and is close to I-380. Commuter rail service is provided by Caltrain between San Francisco and San Jose/Gilroy. The two BART stations reach the entire Bay Area.

Quality of Life

The presence of nearby areas for recreation enriches quality of life by providing opportunities for everyone. The City manages 144.9 acres of 21 parks, bike paths, playgrounds, and trails, as well as 59.5 acres of open space.

The city has nearly seven miles of beautiful shoreline along the San Francisco Bay in connection with the regional Bay Trail.

Community events such as art fairs, Farmers Markets, Halloween parades, and concerts in the park foster social and cultural enrichment and bring people together to build a sense of local community.

The City's Sculpture Garden showcases public art, which celebrates public space and the identity of the community.

Childcare and Adult Day Care enhance the quality of life in the community and has constructed a childcare facility. The Adult Day Care program serves frail adults in need of assistance during the day.

Hotels & Conference Center

South San Francisco hotels cater primarily to San Francisco International Airport users, serving the business and budget traveler and the airline industry market segments. Shopping Centers

The traditional regional retail market is highly competitive in northern San Mateo County, with the City of South San Francisco ranked third in sales among the 20 cities in the county.

The City of South San Francisco is served mainly by 11 neighborhood and community retail centers totaling 58,330 square feet. But, the city is also well served by regional retail uses. The city is home to three Costco stores, Giorgi Brothers Furniture, Safeway and Pacific Supermarkets, Lowes Home Improvement, Harley Davidson Motorcycles, Staples, Broadmoor Lumber, Dollar Tree, Trader Joe's, and Walgreen's Drug Stores.





Bay Area Schools

The Bay Area and San Mateo County's public education districts offer exceptional education opportunities and are rated above the state average. South San Francisco Unified School District, with 9 elementary, 3 middle schools, and 3 high schools, is rated above the state average. The City offers special programs that enhance the student's educational experience, such as STEM and robotics classes. Students may take advantage of internships that are offered by local companies. The map below shows the regional school districts ratings, ranging from the low, "1", to the highest, "10", with "5" used as the state average.

Expedited Permit Processing

Customer service is the priority that guides and shapes all City operations. The Permit Center at 315 Maple Avenue features a state-of-the-art permit center that is fully staffed and open 45 hours per week. City staff work together collaboratively to get businesses through the permit process as fast as possible. The City continues to streamline regulations, coordinate with other permitting agencies and improve efficiency using new technology, such as electronic plan check.

Financial Support Services

The City of South San Francisco's Economic Development staff can help you explore the best options for meeting your company's financial needs. We can also link you to tax incentives, tax credits, or other financial programs. We partner with several private and public lenders that offer low-interest loans, capital assistance, workforce development, clean energy, and other financial services.

- SBA and other loan programs.
- CalCAP - a State program that provides cash to cover collateral shortfalls.
- Industrial Development Bonds.
- Other financing tools, such as various micro loan funds.
- On the Job Training & Employment Training Panel
- PACE financing

Access to Capital

Access to Venture Capital and Angel Financing centers:

Local companies have attracted venture capital to explore and create new products and services. The Bay Area has 34% of all active venture capital firms in the United States. In 2014-15, venture capital firms invested over \$360 million in South San Francisco companies.

New City and State Incentives:

State incentives (such as Cal Competes), Employment Training Panel and we are a targeted area (TEA) for EB-5. We have regional collaborations with Bay Bio, Joint Venture Silicon Valley and other groups.

City Support for Small- and Medium-Size Firms:

We have three REITs that build exclusively for the biotech industry on 16 R&D campuses and nearly 11 million square feet of space. Sublease space is now opening up in the SSF Market. Contact us now!
